Dr. Spring explained that Mr. Jamie Dilbone, Energy Educator, would do a brief presentation and present an award to the Board of Education.

Mr. Dilbone showed a PowerPoint presentation on how the district is doing after 27 months into the program with EEI. He explained the district has shown a 30% savings in energy costs since the start of the program and has far exceeded the expected savings projected by EEI. Mr. Dilbone presented the Board with three Energy Star Awards which the district received for Bradt, Draper Middle School and Mohonasen High School. He stated that we are one of only three other districts nationwide who have achieved this designation. The district also earned "top performer" status from EPA and is only the 7th school district in New York State to get this designation.

Dr. Spring stated that much of the success of the program is due to Mr. Dilbone. Mr. Dilbone thanked Mrs. Swezey and Dr. Spring for all their support.
