



Mohonasen Central School District

*Minutes of Annual School District Meeting
Tuesday, May 18, 2010 – High School Gym*

The meeting was called to order at 6:57 AM by Mr. David McNamara, Permanent Chairman, who asked the inspectors to inspect the voting machines to be used for voting and sign the required affidavits. The polls were declared officially opened at 7:00 AM.

At 9:00 PM Mr. David McNamara, Permanent Chairman, declared the voting to be ended and the voting machines were inspected and closed; absentee ballots were opened and tallied. The inspectors officially certified the following results:

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Rotterdam-Mohonasen Central School District, Towns of Rotterdam, Schenectady County, and Colonie and Guilderland, Albany County, New York, be authorized to expend the sum of Forty-Two Million Seven Hundred Twenty Thousand One Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$42,720,170) for school purposes during the 2010-2011 school year and levy the necessary tax therefore.

Proposition One- Buses:

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Rotterdam-Mohonasen Central School District, Towns of Rotterdam, Schenectady County, and Colonie and Guilderland, Albany County, New York, is hereby authorized to pay the cost of the purchase of school buses of and for said School District, including incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, at a maximum estimated cost of Three Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$390,000) and providing for the levy of a tax therefore to be collected in installments, with obligations of said School District to be issued in anticipation thereof in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$390,000).

Proposition Two - Land:

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Rotterdam-Mohonasen Central School District, Towns of Rotterdam, Schenectady County, and Colonie and Guilderland, Albany County, New York be authorized to purchase approximately 36 acres of real property and a residence located on Serafini Drive, Rotterdam, New York at a cost to the District of \$1,425,000, plus usual and customary closing costs, and to expend such monies from the Capital Reserve Fund for such purchase.

Mr. Cafarelli and Mr. Sabatini will serve three-year terms from July 1, 2010 until June 30, 2013.

MOTION made by Mr. Joseph Salamone, seconded by Mrs. Eileen French, that all proceedings of this Annual School District Meeting be ratified and confirmed, to wit: the proposed budget for the 2010-2011 school year in the amount of \$42,720,170 was approved; the expenditure of \$390,000 for the purchase of buses was approved; the expenditure of \$1,425,000 plus usual and customary closing costs for the purchase of approximately 36 acres of real property and a residence located on Serafini Drive, Rotterdam, New York; and Dominic Cafarelli and Mark Sabatini were elected to the Board of Education. The motion was approved unanimously by all those present, approximately twenty district residents.
