



Mohonasen Central School District

*Minutes of Annual School District Meeting
Tuesday, May 17, 2011 – High School Gym*

The meeting was called to order at 6:58 AM by Mr. David McNamara, Permanent Chairman, who asked the inspectors to inspect the voting machines to be used for voting and sign the required affidavits. The polls were declared officially opened at 7:00 AM.

At 9:00 PM Mr. David McNamara, Permanent Chairman, declared the voting to be ended and the voting machines were inspected and closed; absentee ballots were opened and tallied. The inspectors officially certified the following results:

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Rotterdam-Mohonasen Central School District, Towns of Rotterdam, Schenectady County, and Colonie and Guilderland, Albany County, New York, be authorized to expend the sum of forty-two million nine hundred four thousand five hundred sixty-one dollars (\$42,904,561) for school purposes during the 2011-2012 school year and levy the necessary tax therefore.

Proposition - Buses:

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Rotterdam-Mohonasen Central School District, Towns of Rotterdam, Schenectady County, and Colonie and Guilderland, Albany County, New York, is hereby authorized to pay the cost of the purchase of school buses of and for said School District, including incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, at a maximum estimated cost of Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$370,000) and providing for the levy of a tax therefore to be collected in installments, with obligations of said School District to be issued in anticipation thereof in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$370,000).

Mrs. del Prado and Mr. Moran will serve three-year terms from July 1, 2011 until June 30, 2014.

MOTION made by Mrs. French, seconded by Mr. Spadaro, that all proceedings of this Annual School District Meeting be ratified and confirmed, to wit: the proposed budget for the 2011-2012 school year in the amount of \$42,904,561 was approved; the expenditure of \$370,000 for the purchase of buses was approved; and Nancy del Prado and Mark Moran were elected to the Board of Education. The motion was approved unanimously by all those present, approximately twelve district residents.

MOTION made by Mrs. del Prado, seconded by Mr. Mrs. French, that the meeting be adjourned at 9:35 PM.
