This assignment is to be completed individually by the student and will count for one quiz grade each. If the assignment is not completed, or is missing, an INC will be issued (only a score of 65% can be earned upon completion).

The assignment is due **Friday, September, 10th**. Students should be prepared to complete a writing assignment **in class** based on the information they have provided in their summer reading charts. Students will be able to use their charts to assist them with this project.

The scoring rubric for the Summer Reading Assignment will be:

100% for exceptional work

90% for very good work

80% for good work

70% for satisfactory work
