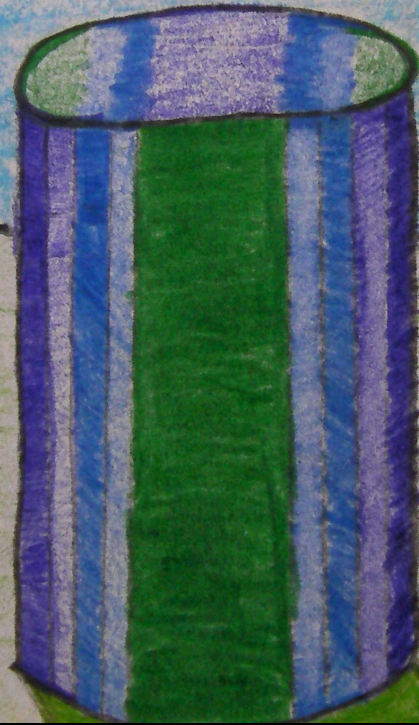


Directions:

1. practice drawing several ellipses on the back of the paper
2. on the front of the paper draw one ellipse at the top
3. draw two vertical lines down from the left and right side of the ellipse, 5-6"
4. draw a second ellipse which will connect the two vertical lines and it should be parallel to the top ellipse (curves should match up)
5. draw one diagonal line behind the cylinder and not drawn through it (this will represent the table line)
6. choose 3-4 colors 1 of each: dark,



7. choose one side which will be where the light is shining brightest
8. color the area where the light is shining brightest using your lightest color, then as you move away from the brightest section use medium then dark values
9. when coloring the cylinder, color left to right using a curve matching that of the cylinder
10. to blend colors lightly color a darker color over a lighter color
11. Color in a background and table (area below the diagonal line)
*** use colors that make the cylinder stand out not the background***
12. draw a shadow on the table area using black or a darker color : the shadow will be darkest
