Painting Directions: (2<sup>nd</sup> Phase)

**\*\*Remember to achieve a darker color you layer 1 lighter color over a medium color until the correct value of darkness is achieved\*\***

**\*\*To create a secondary color**

i.e.; green, you layer a medium value of yellow over a lighter value of blue, Color change is achieved through layering of colors NOT Mixing in the palette.

1. Always start with a lighter value of a color layer to increase value darkness
2. Try to create the colors that identically match the animal photograph that you are working from
3. Try not to use too much water on your brush at any time
