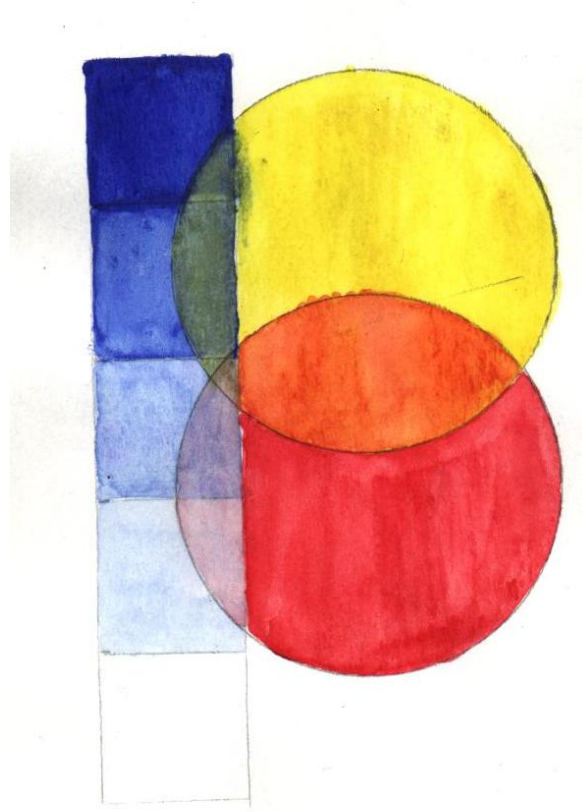

**Essential Task 5**  
**Watercolor Color Chart**



Directions: ***PAIN** NEATLY!!*

*Do NOT use too much water or use paint Directly from the paint tray*

1. Draw (using your ruler) 1 vertical rectangle to these dimensions: 1" wide x 5" long, then divide this rectangle into 1" x 1" squares.
2. Now draw 2 circles and have them overlap each other and the rectangle you just drew (you can use the bottom of a cup)
3. Next paint the top square in the rectangle with blue watercolor paint and just a touch of water (this will be your darkest square). Gradually add more water to the paint mixture as you fill in the rest of the squares. The last square at the bottom will be the lightest blue containing just a trace of blue paint. Let dry
4. Now paint the top circle yellow, not too dark use 50/50 water and paint, do not paint the area of the circle that overlaps the blue first, paint that last
5. Next, paint the bottom circle red (50/50) paint to water mix, again make sure to paint the area of the circle that does not overlap either yellow circle or blue squares. Lastly, paint the parts of the circle that overlap the yellow circle (rinse your brush in water), and then paint the part of the circle that overlaps the blue squares.
