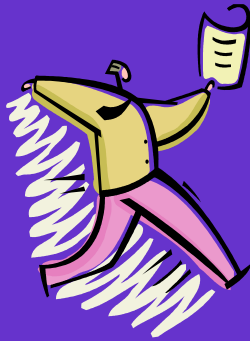

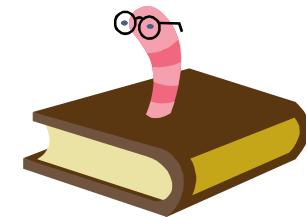

Attendance, Absences & Tardiness

Written excuses are required within 3 days

Students who are absent from school must submit a written excuse, signed by a parent or guardian, within three days of the student's return or their attendance record will permanently reflect an unexcused absence. The excuse should indicate the reason for and the date(s) of the absence.

Excused: Absence due to personal illness, family illness or death, medical/dental appointments, impassable roads due to inclement weather, religious observances, quarantine, required court appearances, approved college visits, approved cooperative work programs, military obligations or other special circumstances approved by the district.

Unexcused: Any absence that does not fit the above categories, e.g., family vacation, hunting, babysitting, hair cut, obtaining a learner's permit, taking a road test, oversleeping, etc.

HOW YOU CAN HELP YOUR STUDENT BE SUCCESSFUL

- Be sure your student is eating healthy and is getting proper sleep.
- Be sure your student is dressed appropriately for school. No strapless or thin-strapped apparel, no revealing undergarments, no portion of chest, abdomen, back and upper leg area accepted, and no bedroom apparel, including slippers.
