Information for the College Bound

- Most four-year and some two-year schools require the SAT/ACT college entrance exams.
- Register online or pick up registration materials in the Counseling and Career Center .
- Practice exam/test taking tips booklets are also available.
- Test dates are listed on the back of each booklet.
- The SAT includes math, critical reading and writing sections.
- The ACT includes sections in English, math, reading and science and we recommend taking the ACT with the writing option, as some colleges require it. **Some colleges will use the ACT w/ writing in place of SAT Subject Tests.**
- If you are anticipating applying to very competitive schools such as BC, BU or Cornell, you should check their websites and talk to an admissions representative regarding their SAT subject exams requirements
- Some particular college majors such as science and engineering also require SAT subject tests.

You should be taking the SAT and/or ACT Tests this SPRING!

Register by February 4th for the March 13th exam.

Register by March 25th for the May 1st exam.

Register by April 29th for the June 5th exam.

ACT Registration Dates are:

Register by March 5th for the April 10th exam.

Register by May 7th for the June 12th exam.

*Late registration dates are listed and require an additional \$23 or \$21.
