Getting to the Text On-line

Follow the given directions to get your Algebra textbook on any computer.

Remember to write your Homework assignments neatly on paper with the assignment number and show your work for full credit.

1. If at school, log on to your school (academic) account and open internet explorer.
2. Type in <http://my.hrw.com> in the address bar.
3. Type in the username and password I gave you. Do not save it to school computers but you certainly can at home.
4. When logged on, there may be "assignments" waiting for you. Click on them for specific directions when I advise you to do so.
5. If not, just click the text.
6. There are 2 scroll down menus at the top waiting for you. The first selects the chapter; the second selects the sections of the chapter. We begin with chapter 1, lesson 1-1. Select both and the book will open to that section. You can type in the page of your HW and then "enlarge" the print to suit yourself.
7. You will notice links to "EXAMPLES 1,2,3 and 4 " These are tutorial videos of that lesson. Open one whenever you need support for a lesson.
8. There are interactive quizzes available to help you study in each lesson. Click the link and the questions get checked for you, with hints if you need them.

It will not take long before you become familiar with the "ins and outs" of being on-line with your math book. I hope you find the site helpful, useful and easy to access. Any questions or problems, just see me.
