*Minutes of Annual School District Meeting
Tuesday, May 17, 2016 – High School Gym*

The meeting was called to order at 6:58 AM by Mr. Wayne Calder, Permanent Chairperson, who asked the inspectors to inspect the voting machines to be used for voting and sign the required affidavits. The polls were declared officially opened at 7:00 AM.

At 9:00 PM Mr. Wayne Calder, Permanent Chairperson, declared the voting to be ended, absentee ballots were opened and scanned, and the voting machines were inspected and closed. The inspectors officially certified the following results:

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Rotterdam-Mohonasen Central School District, Towns of Rotterdam, Schenectady County, and Colonie and Guilderland, Albany County, New York, be authorized to expend the sum of forty-eight million three hundred sixty-five thousand four hundred nine dollars (\$48,365,409) for school purposes during the 2016-2017 school year and levy the necessary tax therefore.

Proposition - Buses:

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Rotterdam-Mohonasen Central School District, Towns of Rotterdam, Schenectady County, and Colonie and Guilderland, Albany County, New York, is hereby authorized to pay the cost of the purchase of school buses of and for said School District, including incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, at a maximum estimated cost of five hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$560,000.00) and providing for the levy of a tax therefore to be collected in installments, with obligations of said School District to be issued in anticipation thereof in an amount not to exceed five Hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$460,000.00).

Robert Piccirillo and Deborah Escobar will serve three-year terms from July 1, 2016 until June 30, 2019.

MOTION made by Ms. Pacheco, seconded by Mr. Cafarelli, that all proceedings of this Annual School District Meeting be ratified and confirmed, to wit: the proposed budget for the 2016-2017 school year in the amount of \$48,365,409 was approved; the expenditure of \$560,000 for the purchase of buses was approved; and Robert Piccirillo was re-elected and Deborah Escobar was elected to the Board of Education. The motion was approved unanimously by all those present, approximately 21 district residents.
