How do you participate?

If you already have an idea, you can fill that out, but if you need more time to come up with an idea, that's ok too. Plus you can always change your mind if your original plan isn't working out.

2- You can work on your own project, or you can work with a friend, or you can even work with a group of friends!

3- The project should be made primarily of cardboard and some sort of tape (masking, duct tape, etc..). You can add other things to your project, but it should be mostly made out of cardboard.

4- Let us know if you need help with your project. Check off if you need help and plan to attend our Extra Help night on Thursday, September 21 from 6-7 at Pinewood. Let us know if you need help with an idea, with materials, or with construction. We will have teachers and older students meet you at school to help you get started!

5- When your project is complete, bring it into school and it will be displayed for everyone to appreciate. Projects are due by Monday, October 2nd. All projects can be brought to the Science Lab.

6- Three Cardboard Challenge Projects from each grade level will be selected to be highlighted at our Mohonasen Manufacturing Day on October 6th at the CAT building!
