Mrs. Gaglioti congratulated the IT department on a job well with virtual learning being off to a good start.</p> <p>Ms. MacTurk recognized Pinewood for doing a great job on the first day of school.</p> <p>Ms. Escobar indicated that she was very impressed with the remote learning that the District was providing.</p> <p>Ms. Gaglioti said that the first day was spectacular and recognized the efforts of the IT Department, teachers, students and administrators to get everything up and running for the start of school. She also encouraged patience as the District works through issues with reopening.</p>
