SUBJECT: Request for Approval of Health and Welfare Contract with Guilderland Central School District

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 912 of the Education Law permits a school district to enter into a contract for the purpose of providing health and welfare services for children residing in a school district and attending non-public schools located in a different school district.

EVALUATION/ANALYSIS

A review of district records indicates 31 students residing in the Mohonasen Central School District are receiving health and welfare services from the Guilderland Central School District. The cost of these services is \$635.62 per student for the 2020-2021 school year, at a total of \$19,704.22. The district should now enter into a contract with the Guilderland Central School District, in the total amount of \$19,704.22.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Education approve a health and welfare contract with the Guilderland Central School District, in the total amount of \$19,704.22 for the 2020-2021 school year.

SUBJECT: Request Approval for Tax Refund – Bigsbee Enterprises

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The district has received a Consent Order and Judgement regarding property owned by Bigsbee Enterprises.

EVALUATION/ANALYSIS

Bigsbee Enterprises filed an appeal for review of their assessment for tax years 2016 through 2019. The Consent Order proposes a settlement of the case that reduces the assessed value for 2019 only. The current assessment is \$1,848,000 and the proposal is to reduce to \$1,748,000, a total reduction of \$100,000 per year. This reduction would result in a total refund of \$1,889.24.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Education authorize the change in assessment, from \$1,848,000 to \$1,748,000 and the corresponding refund of \$1,889.24, for the 2019 tax year.
