Dear Broadalbin-Perth Central School District Board of Education Members,

As fellow school board members at Mohonasen Central School District, we extend our deep appreciation to you for speaking up about the mask mandate. We share your concerns on this issue, and we recognize the courage that it requires to take a stand on this particular subject.

On Saturday, June 12, 2021, we passed a resolution expressing our frustration with the inconsistent and arbitrary guidance and policies coming from New York State. It also petitions the New York State Department of Health to immediately allow K-12 schools to make their own policy decisions pertaining to the advisability of requiring masks for their students, and it asks for immediate relief from the mask mandate.
