Mr. Abbott presented the student representatives with letters and certificates thanking them for their service on the board and wishing them well on their future endeavors.

MTA president, Chris Patterson, thanked the Board and Mr. Shine for their continued support and for their hard work in providing Mohonasen students with the best educational experience possible. MTA representatives then passed out tokens of appreciation to the Board and District Office administrators.

Mr. Bertram thanked the Board and Mr. Shine for their support of the Athletics Department then presented the Annual Athletics Report. He told them that the number of student athletes participating in sports increased every season for the 2021-2022 school year. He reported that several Mohonasen athletes had very notable seasons including Zionna Perez-Tucker in Track, Loren Cuomo in Tennis, and Rachel Miller in Cross Country. Mr. Bertram also informed the Board that 28 school records were broken this school year.

Mr. Ruberti updated the Board on the status of a Capital Project. He indicated that although the bids came in well over the projected \$3.25 million budget that the District was still able to award some of the work via state contract. He also indicated that the District was working with the CS Arch to reduce some of the scope of the project and will rebid the most time sensitive components. Mr. Ruberti indicated that he would update the Board throughout the process.

The Board discussed the schedule of meetings for 2022-2023 Mr. Shine explained that most Boards have one to two meetings a month and Mohonasen usually has two. Mr. McFarland noted that he thought the presentations and having two meetings a month, with some flexibility, are important. Mrs. Montagino asked why there was not a 2nd meeting in April. Mr. Shine responded that there was a compression with the weeks being so close together. Mr. Abbott added that two meetings a month is a good balance.

Mrs. Power wished to recognize the Mohonasen Music Department accomplishments from the youngest students all the way up to the teachers. Mr. Shine agreed and added that key hires have sustained the legacy.

Mr. McFarland expressed his concern after the recent events in Uvalde, Texas. He said that every parent has concerns and would like to see their children’s schools “hardened” against security threats. He asked to discuss the concept of one school resource officer (SRO) for the District and wished to know more about the compensation structure. Mr. Shine responded that the District pays 100% of his salary while he is at the school. Mr. Shine added that a few months ago the SRO conducted a safety and security audit with suggestions on areas that can be improved which has already resulted in some upgrades to the security structure of the District. Mr. McFarland and Mrs. Montagino said they would like to hear more about funding for more SROs at the elementary schools. Mr. McFarland said he would like to hear from the administrators and teachers about their safety concerns. Mr. Abbott pointed out that situations like this show just how important social and emotional well-being is for our students. It was suggested by Mrs. Montagino that the SRO do an audit every year to identify areas of security risks. It was agreed that the details of security measures and risks should not be discussed in public forums.
