The faculty, staff, and administration are excited to announce our last *Bring Your Best Day!* On Friday, May 12, Draper students will complete their IXL and STAR360 benchmarks. As part of the experience, students will earn points for the work completed during the day; each *Bring Your Best Day* has allowed students to earn points, leading to a chance to win a grand prize through a raffle drawing. Here's how the point system works:

- Completing the IXL diagnostic earns 1 point
- Completing the STAR360 diagnostic earns 1 point
- Completing STEM Activity earns 1 point

In addition to earning points for the grand prize, students will also receive a participation reward for their work during the day. For this *Bring Your Best Day*, students in attendance will receive one item from Mr. Ding-A-Ling during their lunch.

Students should report to school as normal; however, they should go to the designated room as described below (instead of following their regular schedule):

- Grade 6 - report to your AC 1/2 class at 7:30am
- Grade 7 - report to your AC 8/9 class at 7:30am
- Grade 8 - report to your AC 8/9 class at 7:30am
