Report to an adult if any areas of the floor are wet to prevent accidents

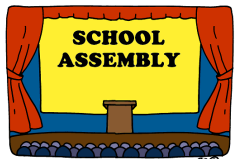
Be a responsible bystander; offer help or tell the teacher
Get in, get out

Keep hands, feet and other objects to yourself
Keep area clean
Quiet voices

Wash hands with 1 pump of soap and turn off the water
Knock gently and politely
Leave the door unlocked when not in use

Use urinals and toilets as they are meant to be used
Flush
Throw garbage in the trash cans
Report problems to adults
Give others their privacy

Assembly



Report to an adult if any areas of the floor are wet to prevent any accidents

Keep hands and body to yourself
Whole body listening
Sit on bottoms

Applaud with your hands only at designated times
Sit quietly (Level 0 or 1) during transitions

Stay seated until dismissed
Enter and exit in a quiet, calm and orderly manner
