Mr. Shine welcomed the Mohonasen Marching Band and congratulated them on winning the 2023 State Championship. Director, Jason Varga, thanked the Board and Mr. Shine for their continuous support. Several band members spoke about how much being part of the marching band has meant to them. The students then displayed their many trophies to the Board.

Students representatives gave the Board an overview of various activities happening at each of the schools. Sara reported that Bradt had the author of Parmesan Pig, Ben Barrowmen visit and Halloween celebrations were held in the classrooms. Gino said at Pinewood the winners of the Character Counts -Respect award were celebrated with a recognition breakfast and the annual Halloween Monster Dash was held. Nick and London noted that Draper held their Halloween Teen Town and it was well attended and fourteen students were honored for being Student of the Month. At the High School, Sara said that the play, "All I Know I Learned in Kindergarten ", was very successful and the annual Mohon Bowl was held. Gino reported that the High School Unified Bocce Ball Team was featured in the Daily Gazette.

Mrs. Smith gave a presentation on Bradt's 2023-2024 Building Goals. These goals are all aimed to align with the District's Portrait of a Graduate. The goals included increasing the percentage of students reading at or above reading level, decreasing absenteeism, reducing the number of disciplinary referrals by 10%, implementing the use of Class DoJo to communicate with families, and focus on long range budget plans and goals. The Board followed up with several questions.

Mr. Shine presented the Board members with golf umbrellas for Board Appreciation week and thanked them for their service.

The Board agreed that security of the schools is a number one priority. Mr. Shine added this is an opportunity to reteach and relearn and that the high school was assessing protocols.

Mrs. Power asked for clarification on the free breakfast and lunch. Mr. Shine said the whole district is free for all meals. Mr. Ruberti added there has been an increase in participation at both breakfast and lunch and that it is expected that this will continue to climb as more students and families realize that meals are free Mr. Shine indicated that he would continue to update the board on participation numbers in the future.

Mrs. Ciampino said that many teachers came to the last football/cheer game for the youth football league and thought that it was a nice gesture and showed the connection to the community.
