Minutes of Meeting of the Board of Education Monday, June 5, 2023 Farnsworth Technology Center/Mohonasen High School

Call to Order

The Board meeting was called to order by the President, Mr. Abbott, at 6:35 PM. Mr. Abbott requested those present to stand and join in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

<u>Communications - Superintendent</u>

Student representatives, Ella Obie, Evan Pena-Ramirez, Gino Palleschi and Kyleigh Millett gave the Board an overview of recent events at each of the schools. At Bradt four students got a surprise homecoming by their father who has been deployed for the last year; at Pinewood 297 participated in the Spring Concert which is almost half of the school population involved with the music program; Draper Middle School orchestra and select choir students participated in the Great East Musical Festival then went to Six Flags New England for a field trip; the High School held a signing ceremony for 11 athletes who have committed to playing sports in college.

Mr. Abbott then recognized the student representatives for their monthly updates and said they were the highlights of the Board meetings. He wished them great success in their future endeavors and presented the students with certificates and Mohonasen pins.

Mohonasen Teachers' Association representatives Lori Giattino, Liesha Sherman, and Maureen Geagan handed out some treats and thanked the Board for all of their hard work and they look forward to continuing to work together.

Matt Ronca presented the Annual Athletic Report to the Board. He noted that each athletic season saw an increase in student participation. Mr. Ronca reported that several Mohonasen teams did very well in their divisions including Girls' Swimming and Girls' Bowling being Colonial Council and Section 2 Champions, Unified Bowling being Section

Champions, and Track Section 2 Champions Alexis Brown, Blake Gannon, and Melissa Quinlivan.

The Board discussed the Board of Education meeting schedule for 2023-2024. Mr. Abbott pointed out that the newly elected Board members should have some input on this discussion. It was decided to postpone discussing it further until the next meeting when Mr. Ryan and Mrs. Ciampino could have some input.

Mr. Shine explained that the Board adopts a set of District Goals each year and it was optimal to have that done prior to the reorganization meeting in July. Mr. McFarland noted that it was one of the most important aspects of being on the Board of Education. He also had some questions regarding the student assessments with the pilot programs and asked Mr. Shine to provide some additional information about them. Mrs. Montagino suggested the word "continue" be added to the statement on engaging faculty and staff.

Mr. Abbott gave an update on upcoming changes to Mohonasen's team name and logo. He said the Board had hoped to keep the logo and the Warrior name; however, that will not be possible. He added that if they take the issue to court they would certainly lose and the cost would be significant. At the June 20th meeting the Board will be passing a resolution saying they will comply with the regulation changes by the end of the 2024-2025 school year. Mr. McFarland added that the Board has been saying all along they would welcome the community's input and involvement.

Mr. Shine thanked those who attended the Tenure and Retirement Reception and congratulated the faculty and staff who were honored, including Board members Mrs. MacTurk and Mrs. Gaglioti.
