### <u>Communications -</u> Superintendent

Kathy Lewis of the New York State School Board Association presented Mr. Shine and Mr. Abbott with a banner recognizing Mohonasen as a "Champion of Change" for the Schenectady Community College Instant Admissions program. She congratulated the District and SCCC on being progressive and innovative in education.

Mr. Shine gave the Board an update on the school aged asylum seekers being housed in a local hotel. He said the District has registered 66 students at two registration events held near the hotel and received initial academic testing information as well. He added that Schenectady County was working with the families to ensure all the children receive vaccinations and have a current medical exam. Mr. Shine then discussed what the academic program might look like at different grade levels, but also indicated this would be something that would be continuously assessed. Several of the Board members asked Mr. Shine questions regarding class sizes, classroom availability and hiring additional support.

## **Public Privilege of the Floor**

Members of the community and students addressed the Board on a variety of concerns. The following people spoke during Public Privilege of the Floor: Elizabeth Lewis and Todd Lewis.

### <u>Communications -</u> <u>Board of Education</u>

The Board discussed the timeline for the proposed changes to Mohonasen's team name and logo. Mr. Abbott noted that he does not want to lose Mohonasen's history in the process. Mr. Ryan, Mrs. Ciampino, and Mr. McFarland indicated they would prefer to wait and see the outcome for other district's who are involved in litigation. It was established that the new logo and name should not be introduced mid-year. Mr. Shine said he would at least begin by phasing out the use of the Native American imagery and M with the spear logo.

The Board discussed establishing some parameters regarding public privilege of the floor. After discussing the issue in length and debating various points the following was decided:

- Speakers will each have 4 minutes
- A timer will be visible but not audible
- Public privilege of the floor will be 45 minutes

• Speakers will sign up prior to public privilege of the floor

The Board also discussed updating policy 1510 to reflect these changes.
