<u>Communications - Superintendent</u>

Student representatives, Gino Isabella, Nick Cecucci, London Vasquez, and Sara Smith gave the Board their monthly building updates. At Bradt, the students were excited to try their new book vending machine which recently earned a \$2,500 grant to use to purchase more books; Pinewood student math scores have shown a steady increase of 20% and discipline write-ups are down; Draper teacher, Mr. Leader, was named professional of the month and the PTSO awarded the high honor roll recipients with donuts; the High School opened their own branch of a First New York Credit Union which will be partly operated by student interns and an Academic Achievement Award ceremony was held.

Sara Smith and Gino Isabella presented Mr. Abbott and Mr. McFarland with gifts to thank them for their military service.

Mrs. Logan-King reviewed the results of a recent climate survey completed by the District. The survey asked students, staff, and parents their opinions on current climate indicators such as social emotional learning, supportive academic learning environments, school-family-community partnerships, and restorative practices. Mrs. Logan-King said the information collected will help the District make data driven decisions, monitor progress, understand the perceptions of the stakeholders, and identify areas of focus. The Board asked Mrs. Logan-King some follow up questions and requested they see all the data that was collected.

Mr. O'Connor gave a presentation on Draper Middle School's 2023-2024 Building Goals. These goals are all aimed to align with the District's Portrait of a Graduate. The main priorities for Draper are academics and climate/culture. Mr. O'Connor stressed how essential attendance is for a

student to be successful and how he and his team plans on increasing those numbers. The Board followed up with several questions.
