College Course Credit and Transcript Implications

The following is in regards to any college courses taken at a college or university that are not affiliated with Mohonasen HS. *See the bottom of page for College in the High School (CHS) courses taken at Mohonasen HS during the school year.*

Students should speak with their counselor before registering for any college class.

If the course is not approved by Mohonasen administration, the course will not count as credit for the student at Mohonasen and will not be included on the student's Mohonasen transcript.

1. The course and grade will remain on the student's transcript at that college and WILL be included in the GPA at that college. For example, if a student takes a college class at HVCC and earns a "C" in that class, that "C" will impact the student's GPA at HVCC. If the student enrolls at HVCC, their GPA will start off as a "C" due to that grade.
2. Typically, if another college awards transfer credit for that course at their institution, they will not carry the grade over and it will not impact the student's GPA at the new college; however, there may be exceptions to this. Please check with your potential colleges.

If the course is approved by administration to count as credit at Mohonasen,

3. The course will be included on the student's MHS transcript, designated as a course from that college and awarded the same amount of credit as the corresponding Mohonasen High School course.
4. The grade will be listed on the MHS transcript as it appears on the college transcript (letter or numeric format) but will not be calculated into the student's overall Mohonasen GPA.
5. If a student doesn't want the course and grade listed on their transcript, the student will not receive any high school credit for the course. It may be necessary to take the corresponding Mohonasen course to meet graduation requirements.
6. See #1 and #2 above regarding the impact on college transcripts even if the course is not included on high school transcripts.

College in the High School (CHS) courses taken at Mohonasen HS during the school year automatically earn Mohonasen credit if passed with a 65+. College credit typically requires at least a 75+. Please see #1 and #2 above regarding the impact on college transcripts.
