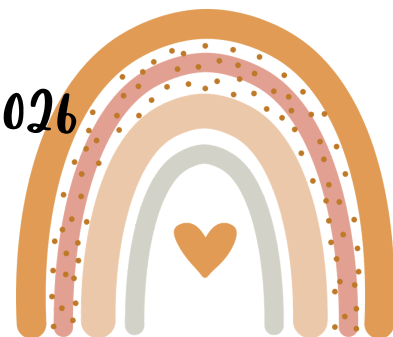

- Details: Register at act.org. Fee waivers are available for those who qualify

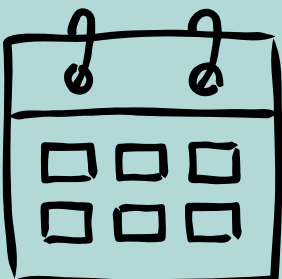


SAT REGISTRATION

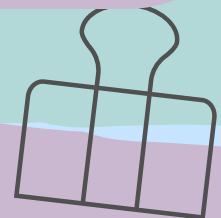
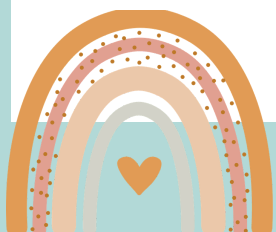
Still want to file your FAFSA & TAP? Act NOW
